

CHRISTIAN FORGIVENESS: A TWO-WAY STREET

Matthew 6: 12, 14-15; Colossians 3:13; Genesis 45:1a

INTRODUCTION

Forgiveness is a core principle of Christianity deeply rooted in the teachings of Jesus Christ.

Believers are called to forgive others just as they have been forgiven by God. (Ephesians 4:32; Colossians 3:13)

Christians are called to forgive unconditionally and perpetually. (Matthew 18:21-22; Luke 17:3-4)

Christian forgiveness is unique because it is based on the forgiveness that God offers through Jesus Christ. (Romans 5:8; 1 John 4:19)

RATIONALE FOR FORGIVENESS (DETAILS)

Forgiveness is a command from God, not just a suggestion.

Our willingness to forgive impacts our relationship with God.

Forgiveness exemplifies Christ's love, grace, and mercy.

Joseph's forgiveness led to personal healing and freedom from resentment.



REPERCUSSIONS OF UNFORGIVENESS

Medically: stress, anxiety, depression, high blood pressure, weakened immune response.

King Saul's Jealousy and Unforgiveness: <u>1 Samuel 18-31</u>


> Spiritual repercussions: withholding of God's forgiveness, hindrance to prayer and worship, spiritual stagnation, broken relationships, lack of inner peace.

REPERCUSSIONS OF UNFORGIVENESS (DETAILS)

Severe punishment for the unforgiving servant. (Matthew 18:35)

Saul's downfall due to jealousy and unforgiveness. (1 Samuel 31:1-6)

Unforgiveness leads to significant spiritual and emotional consequences.
